

Regulation S-P Privacy Notice

Privacy Pledge BNP Paribas Securities Corp.

The confidentiality of personal information of our customers is paramount to our firm and its employees. BNP Paribas Securities Corp. (“BNPPSC”) maintains the highest standards to safeguard personal information of our customers and to comply with privacy rules and regulations as required by the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act. The firm and its employees are committed to protect your personal information and using it in a fair manner.

BNPPSC restricts access to your personal and account information to those employees with a need to know the information in order to provide you with products or services. BNPPSC maintains physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to guard your nonpublic information. We educate our employees to treat personal information with care.

Based upon our relationship with you, BNPPSC collects personal information from and about you that is adequate, relevant and appropriate under the circumstances. This Privacy Pledge details our practices regarding the use, retention and security of the information about you and our compliance in accordance with the USA Patriot Act. For example, BNPPSC may collect, or verify public or nonpublic personal information from or about you from the following sources:

- From information that you provide from applications, forms, and communications and other instructions
- From your transactions that are cleared by BNPPSC
- From nonaffiliated third parties from whom we obtain information about you in connection with our customer relationship, i.e., your creditworthiness. These non-financial entities include verification services, and public reference sources including the internet.
- From nonaffiliated entities that help us process your applications or service your account, such as transfer agents, other clearing entities, printing and mailing your confirmations and account statements; and provide us with consulting, accounting, legal and other services.

BNPPSC might be called upon to provide personal information that you provide from applications, forms and account information to third parties as permitted by law, such as government agencies or respond to a subpoena or court order and a request from a self-regulatory organization that BNPPSC is under their jurisdiction.

BNPPSC does not rent or sell personal information. If you become aware of any discrepancies in your personal information, please notify us and we will make every effort to make the correction immediately.

If you decide to close your account(s) with us or become an inactive customer, the firm will continue to adhere to the Privacy Pledge.
